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SUBJECT: MONKLANDS REPLACEMENT PROJECT SITE SELECTION OPTION APPRAISAL REPORT

1. PURPOSE

The purpose of this paper is to provide Board Members with an update on the next phase of public engagement in relation to the Monklands Replacement Project.
