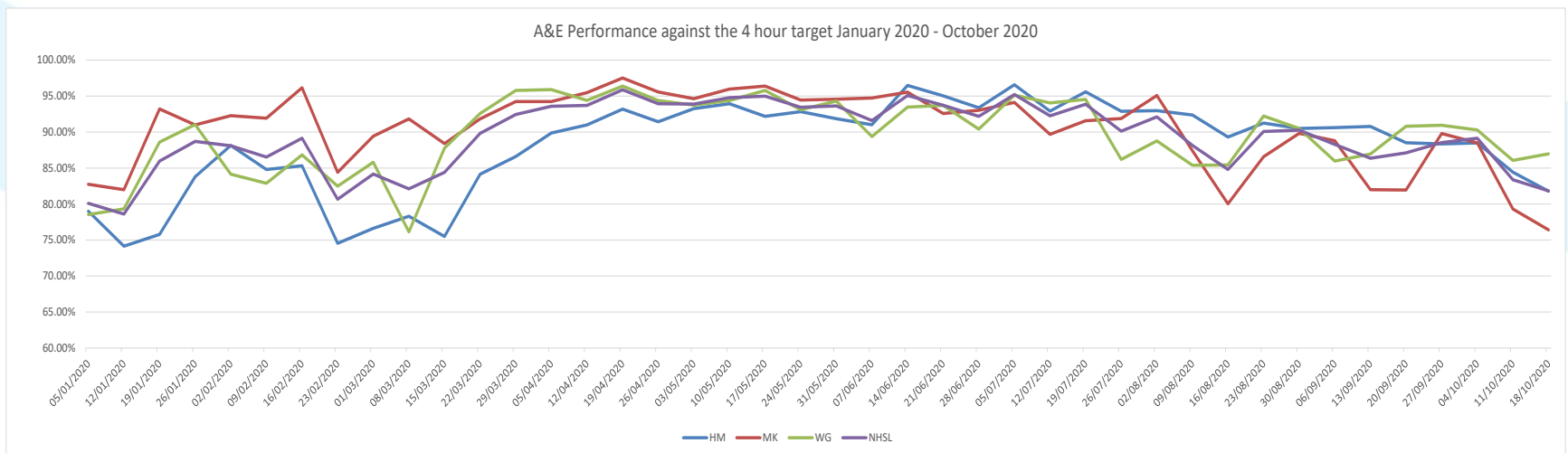
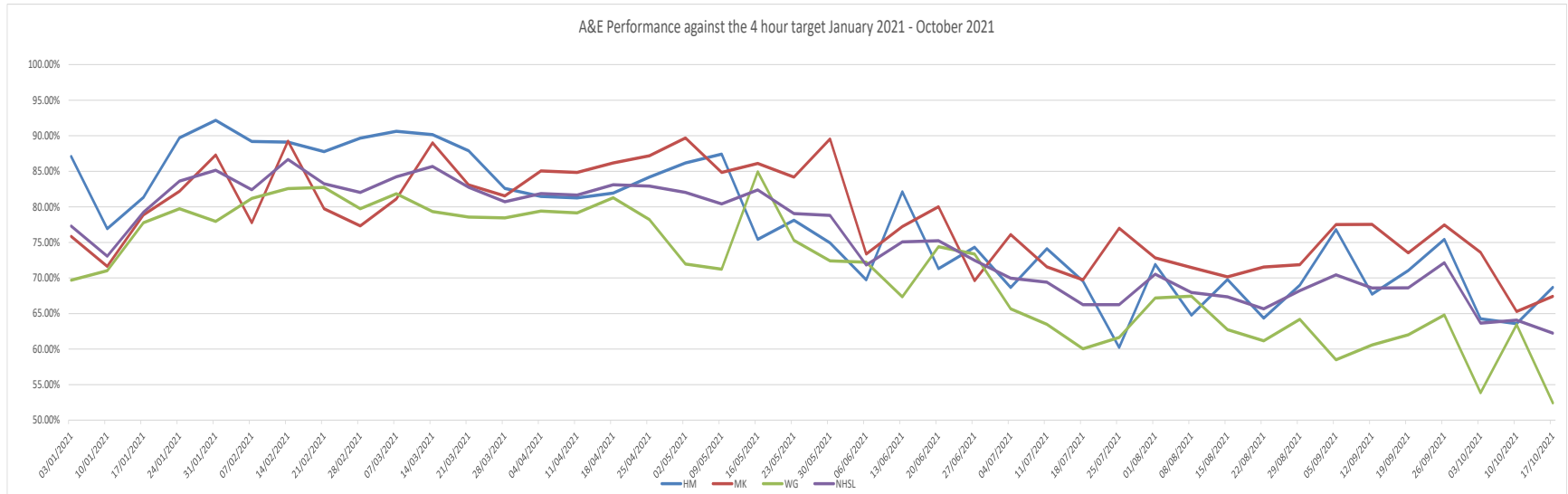
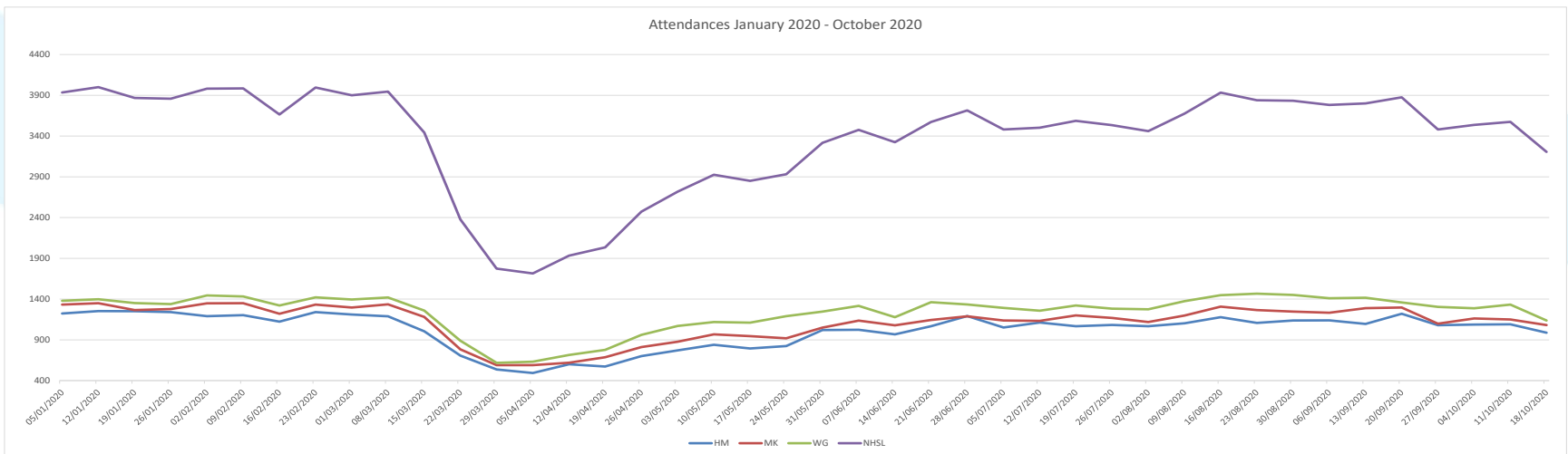
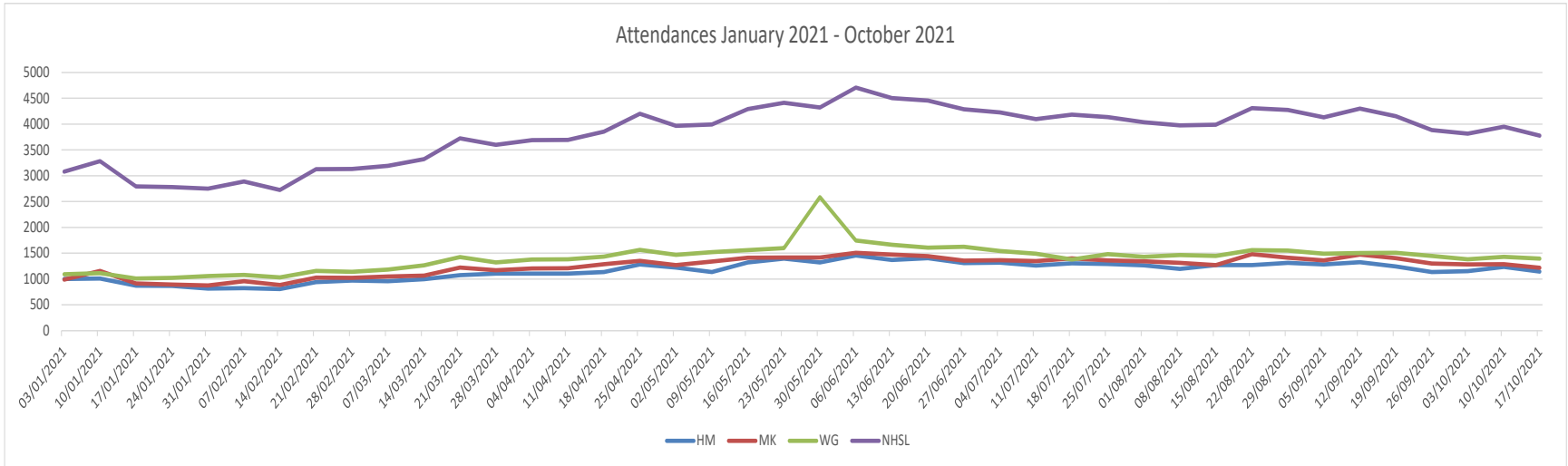


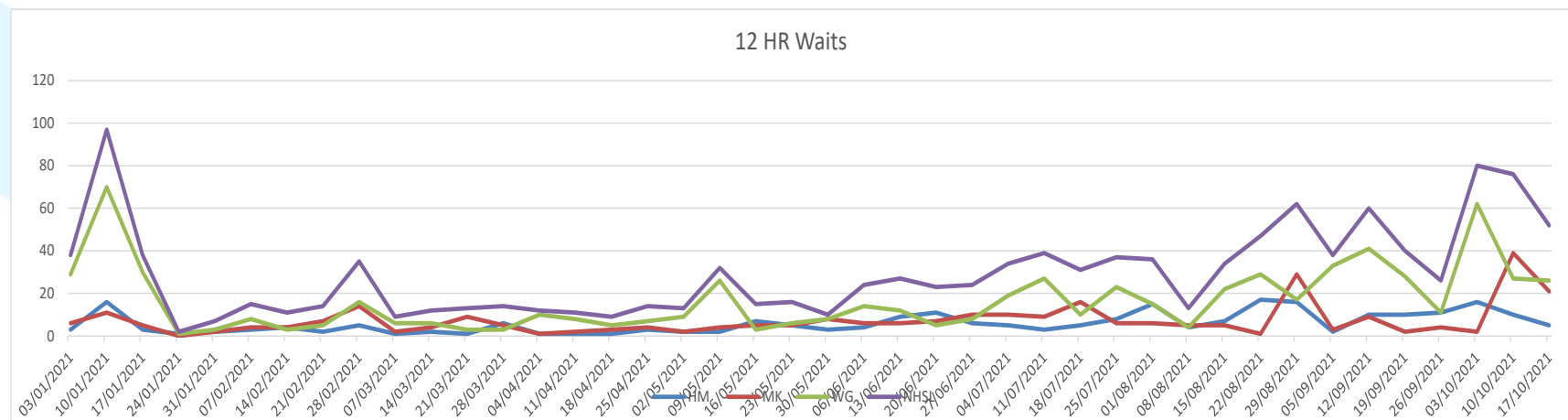
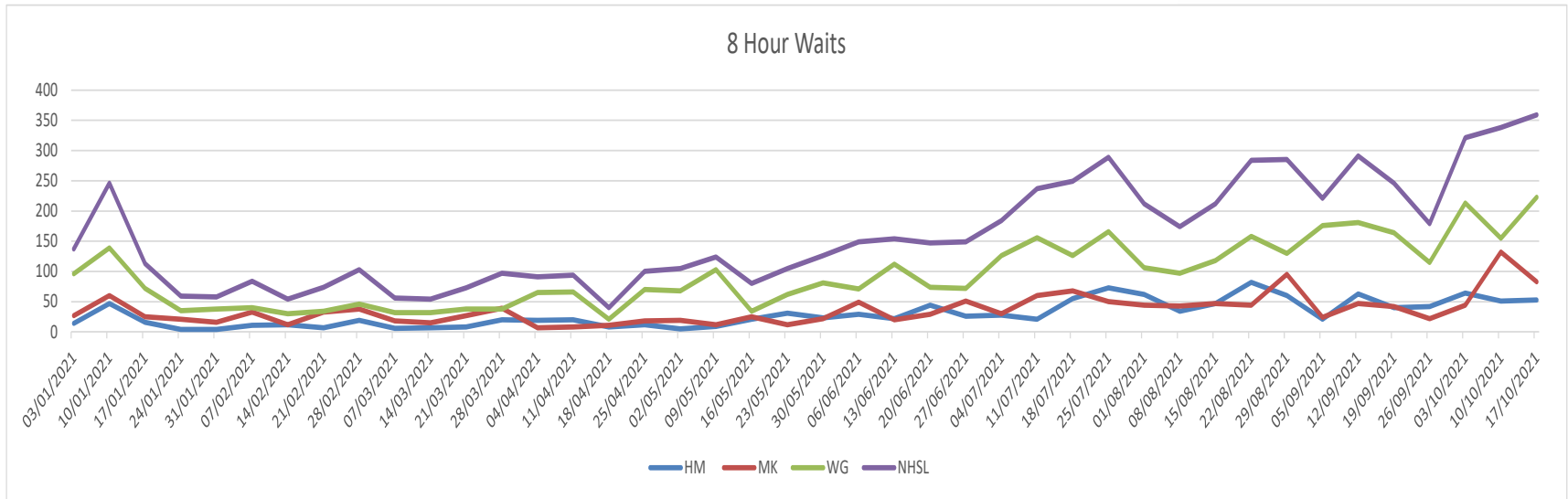
Acute Division A&E Performance Against the 4 hour Target



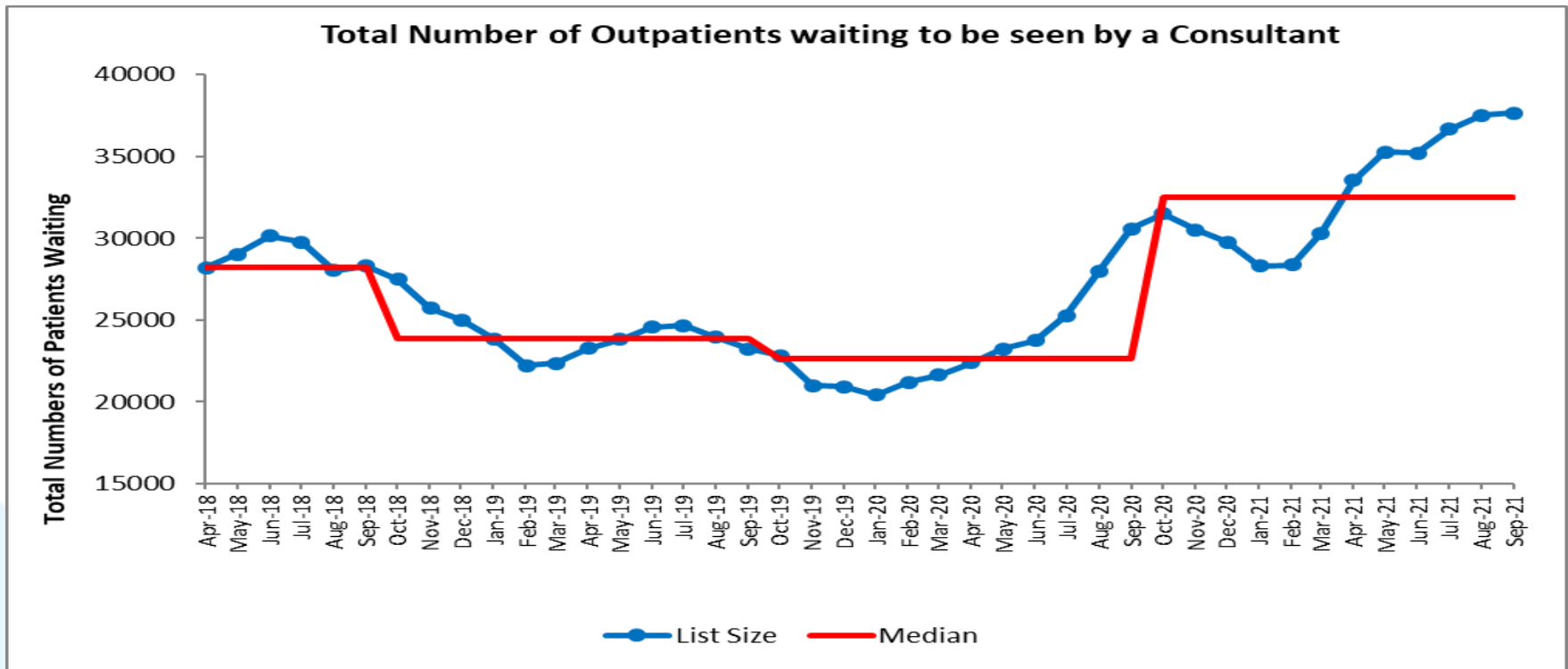
Acute Division A&E Attendances



8 & 12 Hour Breaches January 2021 – October 2021

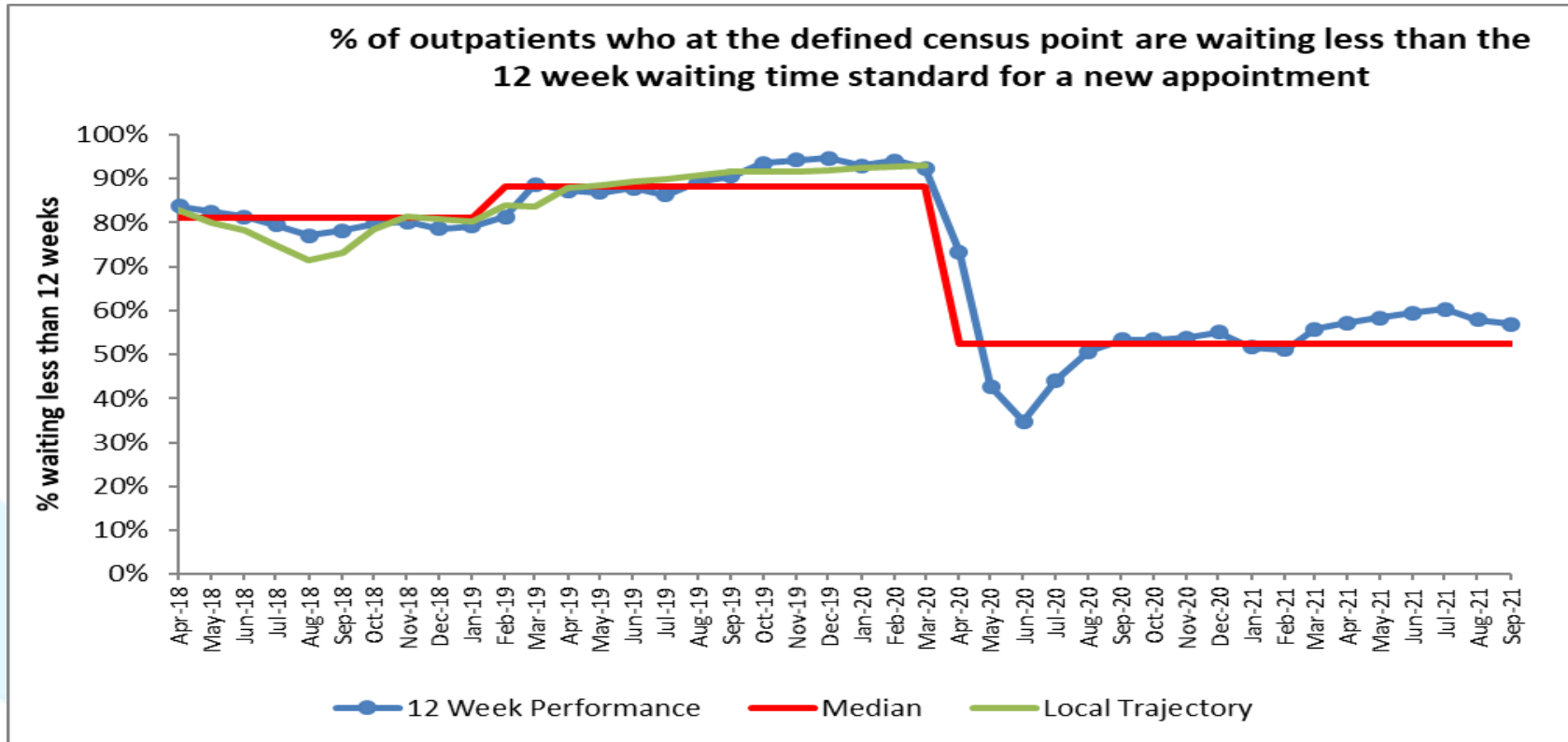


Outpatient Total Waiting List Size

Outpatient 12 Weeks



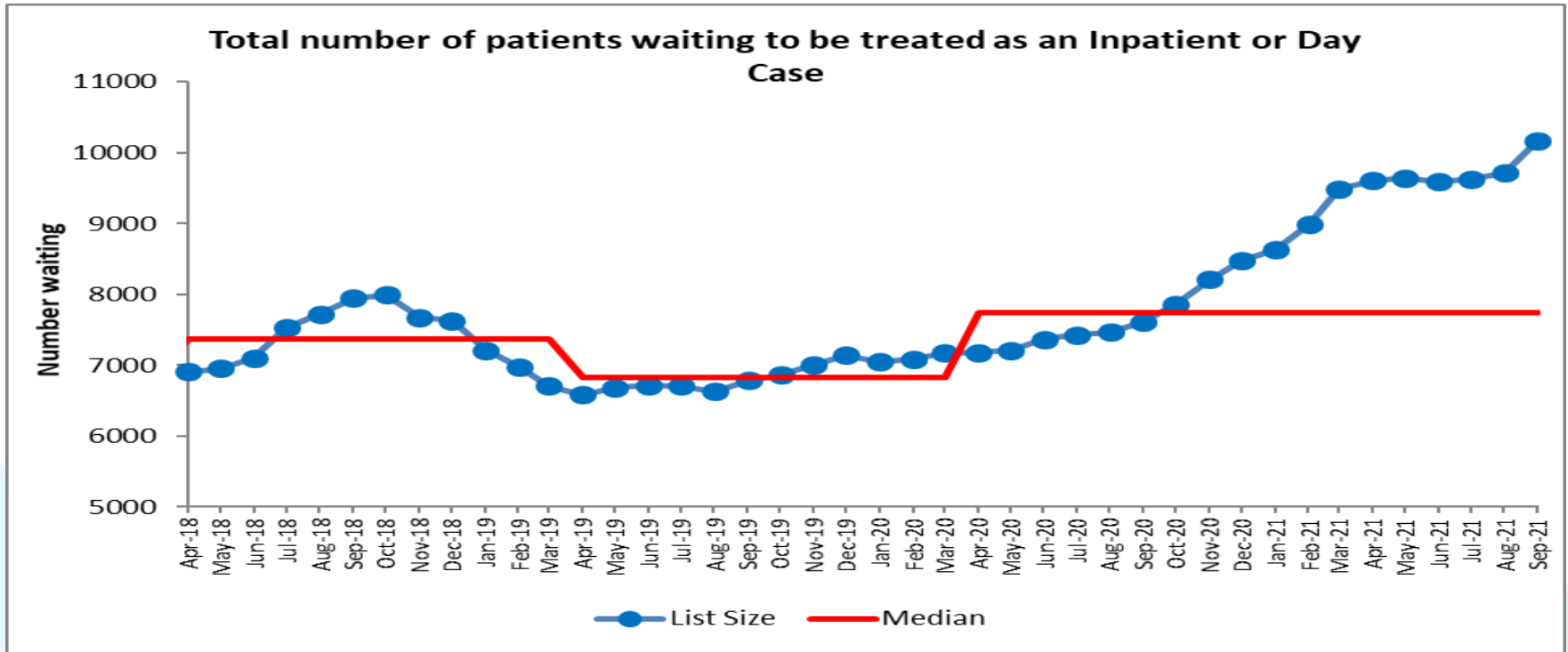

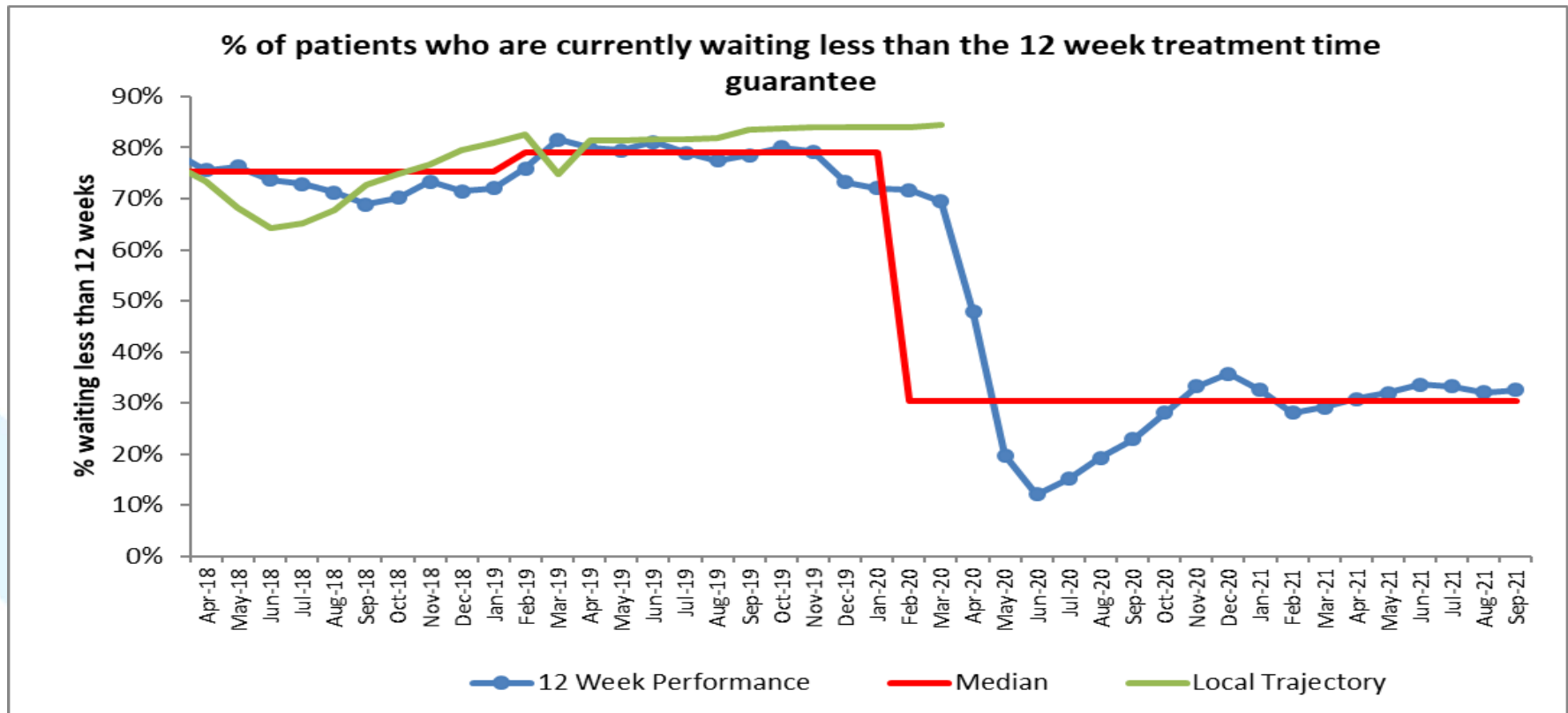
