## THE TEAM

The team is part of a wider mental health service working in the community. We are dedicated to caring for people with young onset dementia, their relatives and carers.

The team includes:

- ❖ Consultant Psychiatrist
- ❖ Clinical Psychologist
- ❖ Community Psychiatric Nurses
- ❖ Occupational Therapist
- ❖ Clinical Support Worker

All members of the team wear, or carry identification badges, please ask if you are not sure who you are seeing.

## WHAT WE DO

We provide assessment, advice and education on the management of dementia. A range of treatment options are offered by the team which include:

- ❖ Mental Health Assessment
- ❖ Psychological Assessment
- ❖ Occupational Therapy Assessment
- ❖ Anxiety and Depression management for people with dementia
- ❖ Memory management
- ❖ Carer education and support around stress and distress in dementia
- ❖ Monitoring the use of prescribed medication

- ❖ Arranging psychiatric admission to hospital during acute episodes of illness when required

- ❖ Liaison with partner agencies

Each person referred to the service will be supported by a Community Psychiatric Nurse (CPN).

## COMMUNITY PSYCHIATRIC NURSE

The CPN will carry out a home visit where appropriate. This nurse will be known as your named nurse and they will carry out an assessment of your needs and will support you through your treatment and care until you are discharged from the service.
