	Squishy mesh ball fidget toy. Gel filled rubbery ball changes shape as you squeeze. www.sensorydirect.com
	Electromites spikey light up fun ball. Squeezable light up rubbery balls.
	No mess play foam pack of four. Mess free doesn't stick to hands. Can be shaped and moulded. Theraputty can be squeezed stretched, twisted or pinched. Different resistances available www.senosrydirect.com
	Hedgehog sensory ball. Designed to stimulate touch and massage muscles of the body. Can also be used for grip and finger exercises www.sensorydirect.com
