It will appear that there is less staff here, don't worry this is normal as your baby improves they require less intensive care. We have a lovely relaxed environment and if you have any questions our staff are on hand to assist.

Our doctors do a ward round every morning just as they do in our main unit- parents are more than welcome for this.

We are located at the top of the main stairs next to ward 24.
