	<p>Why not make your own lava lamp:</p> <p>You will need; Plastic bottle, Vegetable Oil, Water, Food colouring, Alka Seltzer tablet. Fill bottle up quarter with water. Add vegetable oil to water until almost full. Add a few drops of food colouring. Break Alka Seltzer tablet in half and add one half to bottle and it should bubble.</p>
